Birds in Flight is a collection of bird designs that can be used for hand embroidery or appliqué onto just about anything you can imagine! Add these to clothing, a quilt, bag, pillow, or create a beautiful piece of art to hang on the wall. Get really creative and combine the appliqué with embroidery to make something truly unique.

The pattern includes a large sheet of designs that can be traced for appliqué or embroidery, along with ideas and suggestions for stitching. Additional photos inside show the designs on a variety of projects as well as detail for the stitches used.

Suggested Supplies

(will vary depending on how you are choosing to use the designs)

Machine Appliqué:

Heat n Bond Lite

Machine Embroidery thread (rayon or metallic threads recommended)

Monofilament thread (may be used for invisible appliqué)

Fabric for appliqué: quilting cotton, cotton voile, wool, or felt

Hand Embroidery:

Fabric marking pen (I use Frixion pens or a chalk pencil)

Hand Embroidery needle

Light source (bright window or light box)

Hand stitching for these projects was completed with fine threads from **Weeks Dye Works**, specifically pearl 5 and crewel embroidery wool
