Above Knee Length	2 3/4 yards				
Below Knee Length	2 7/8 yards				
Mid-Calf Length	3 yards				
Collar (subtract from above yardage if making from contrast)	1/3 yard				
Trim: Ruffle or Bias	1/2 yard				
Pellon 911FF interfacing	5/8 yard				

All yardage is based on 45° width fabric. Fabric suggestions: cotton, linen, heavy silk, or lightweight twill.

1 1/2" wide belting: 1 yard for sizes XXS-S 1 1/2 yards for sizes M-XXL one 1/4" grommet 1 1/2" belt buckle
